Using oil pastels lines to create movement and texture, we'll also explore warm and cool colour schemes. What animal will you paint? | Space City Printmaking Create a fantastical scene of a city in space, surrounded by looming planets and a rough, harsh terrain. Learn scrape painting and shading techniques to create your planets. We'll print with Lego to create a series of towers and buildings. Inspired by the Japanese animation My Neighbour Totoro, we'll create origami character boxes! Learn origami folding techniques and add character features using drawing and paper cutting techniques.



Create this bright and cheery artwork based on canal houses from Holland using sharpies and watercolour paint. Learn how to use line, pattern and repetition to effectively create an amazing canal scene.



Create a crazy pinch-pot creature using clay and your imagination!
Learn how to mold and shape your clay to make a pinch-pot, then we'll use the scratch attach clay technique to add your own design features to your monster.



Let's create a cute mini cushion of a cat, mouse, or your favourite animal! Learn the whip stitch and running stitch to sew your cushion. Learn how to sew on a button and add smaller pieces of fabric for extra details.



Put on your paleontologist hat and create simple fossils out of air-dry clay. We'll keep your fossils safe by building a wooden paddle pop stick crate to transport your fossils to the museum. Fragile Fossils!
